después de la Guerra Civil, pero su verdadero desarrollo no aparece hasta que los primeros diarios deportivos -Marca, As, Dicen- no se popularizan, unidos a las emisoras de radio, primeras divulgadoras de este lenguaje. Desde esos años hasta hoy ha pasado por tres etapas: iniciación, desarrollo y culminación. En esta última nos encontramos: con un lenguaje plenamente hecho, que comienza a buscar otros caminos. Describir esos nuevos caminos es la misión de este estudio, partiendo del reconocimiento de la gran importancia social, política y económica que hoy tiene el deporte. Estudiamos los géneros deportivos y
