A burn occurs when heat, chemicals, sunlight, electricity or radiation damages skin tissue Most burns happen accidentally There are different degrees of

burns Your healthcare provider determines the seriousness (degree) of a burn based on the depth of the burn and the amount of affected skin Burns can be painful

running water  
or apply a  
cool, wet  
compress until

Mar 2, 2021 · Doctors categorize burns by their severity, or degree. First-degree burns affect only the top layer of skin (the epidermis).

Sunburn is a good example of a first-degree type burn. These burns usually are quite mild, though they may hurt a lot. Second-degree burns penetrate the epidermis and extend into the next layer of skin, the dermis.
