There have been dozens of recordings in part and in whole by artists on the most prestigious record labels. At just over two hours long, the music itself became a self-contained concert experience, performed internationally by some of the world's great interpreters. This deluxe volume of Glass's historic body is to be cherished by music lovers, piano students and players as a lasting heirloom to be passed down from generation to generation.
