Using tax rolls, marriage contracts, and court records as primary sources, Professor Berlanstein

In other words, those in the legal community of Toulouse conducted themselves in ways that were consistent with other members of their social and economic class. To supplement his argument, Berlanstein's integrates methods from the New Social History movement.
