Having published The Hound of the Baskervilles in 1901-1902 (although setting it before Holmes' death) Doyle came under intense pressure to revive his famous character.

Sir Arthur Ignatius Conan Doyle (1859-1930) était un écrivain écossais, célèbre pour ses romans mettant en scène le détective Sherlock Holmes, considéré comme une innovation majeure du roman policier. Cet écrivain prolifique a également travaillé dans le domaine de la science-fiction,

des romans historiques, des pièces de théâtre et de la poésie. Arthur Conan Doyle est né à Edimbourg (Écosse). Il étudie la médecine de 1876 à 1881 après être sorti agnostique des écoles catholiques de son enfance.
