All of these can in turn lead to unjustified discrimination, stigmatization , mental health problems, and partial or total incapacity to work, perpetuating the vicious cycle of neglected diseases as</p>
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both a consequence and a cause of poverty. Patients with chronic conditions caused by NIDs require proper health care in order to prevent further damage and improve their living and social conditions. This should be provided at the primary health care level, as patients suffering from NIDs are often unable to travel to or afford to pay for specialized care services. Care for

patients suffering from chronic morbidity caused by NID should be integrated into care for other chronic conditions caused by non-communicable diseases.
