He writes about growing up in the shadow of a legendary father, skipping school to act in *Mera Naam Joker*, the workings of the musical hits of the era, an encounter with Dawood Ibrahim, his heroines (their working relationship, the gossip and the frisson that was sometimes real), his approach to his craft, his tryst with clinical depression, and more. A foreword by Ranbir Kapoor and a stirring afterword by Neetu Singh bookend the warmest, most *dil se* biography an Indian star has ever penned.
