Who, in 1945 and 1946, could have foreseen that the economic and social integration of the millions of Germans from the East expelled into West Germany after World War II would largely be accomplished in a few years? And, who could have foreseen that

many years after this accomplishment the political repercussions of the expulsions would go on? Yet, surprisingly enough, this is what has happened.
