Les Pensées s'organisent autour de ce schéma ternaire. C'est pourquoi la présente

introduction aux Pensées de Marc Aurèle pourra être lue en un certain sens comme une introduction au stoïcisme antique. N'y aurait-il pas finalement un stoïcisme éternel qui, à travers le temps et l'espace, serait l'une des attitudes possibles de la conscience humaine? Pierre Hadot est depuis 1991 professeur honoraire au Collège de France. Ses recherches se sont concentrées tout d'abord sur les rapports entre hellénisme et christianisme, puis sur la mystique
