En esta legitimación global convergen las ideologías particulares que sustentaron este régimen (falangismo, Carlismo, militarismo, pensamiento eclesial, monarquismo, tecnocracia...) y los cambios sociales, políticos, culturales e internacionales producidos a lo largo de su dilatada historia, pero todo ello no impide analizar el franquismo como un fenómeno unitario. No se pretende una descripción del tratamiento de las lecciones sobre los visigodos o los Reyes Católicos, sino su funcionalidad legitimadora, lo que requiere un desdoble calidoscópico de sus contenidos para poder entender los códigos que encierran.
