pornographic material. But current practices although unintentionally seem to out focus the real Quranic agenda for wealth creation and management. The Quranic alternative to *riba* is trade and commerce (*al-bay'*). The essence of trade and commerce is profit creation that implicates risk-taking (*ghorm*) and value-addition (*kasb*). Doing so promotes fairness and equitable

transactions (*'adl*) and thus putting ethics and morality (*akhlak*) into the limelight of corporate business today. This book has attempted to venture into several issues of Islamic finance that incorporates the Quranic conception of trading and commerce (*al-bay'*).
