Ben Jonson (1572?1637), actor, playwright, satirist, and lyric poet, studied under William Camden at Westminster, worked as a bricklayer, served in the army, and was imprisoned twice—once for sedition and once for murder. *Epicœne*: or, *The Silent Woman* (1609) is considered one of his greatest comedies, upon which, along with *Volpone* (1607), *The Alchemist* (1610), and *Bartholomew Fair* (1614), his reputation rests. At his death, he was regarded as the leading man of

letters in England, and was a major influence on the Cavalier poets, including Robert Herrick, Sir John Suckling, Thomas Carew, and Richard Lovelace. Lester A.
