Para ello se han considerado numerosos caracteres taxonómicos, siendo los de mayor importancia en la delimitación de las especies los relativos al indumento de las plantas, morfología foliar, morfología y tamaño del cáliz, corola y estaminodio, así como la coloración de estos últimos. Como resultado de este estudio se han contabilizado 29 táxones, de los cuales 23 tienen categoría de especie, 3 de subespecie y 3 de variedad, distribuidas en dos secciones: sect. *Scrophularia*, con dos subsecciones (*Scrophularia* y *Vernales*), y sect. *Canina* G. Con motivo de este trabajo se han descrito previamente dos especies nuevas: *S. viciosoi* Ortega Olivencia & Devesa y *S. valdesii* Ortega Olivencia & Devesa. Se descarta para el territorio estudiado la presencia de *S. aquatica* L., *S. laevigata* Vahl, *S. canina* subsp. *bicolor* Sibth. & Sm., *S. lucida* L. y *S. hoppii* Koch, previamente indicadas por algunos autores.
