Ten years after the sequencing of the human genome, scientists have developed genetic tests that can predict a person's response to certain drugs, estimate the risk of developing Alzheimer's disease, and make other predictions based on known links between genes and diseases. At the start of the book, we look upward into treetop scenes, which are followed by images of clouds; eventually we become immersed in an abstract, multi-perspectival entanglement of treetops. Santeri Tuori: *Time Is No Longer Round* is a brilliant exploration of the possibilities of book form, and of the inventive depiction of nature.
