This volume contains the proceedings of the Colloquium "Analysis, Manifolds and Physics" organized in honour of Yvonne Choquet-Bruhat by her friends, collaborators and former students, on June 3, 4 and 5, 1992 in Paris. Its title accurately reflects the domains to which Yvonne Choquet-Bruhat has made essential contributions. Since the rise of General Relativity, the geometry of Manifolds has become a non-trivial part of space-time physics. At the same time, Functional Analysis has been of enormous importance in Quantum Mechanics, and Quantum Field Theory. Its role becomes decisive when one considers the global behaviour of solutions of differential systems on manifolds. In this sense, General Relativity is an exceptional theory in which the solutions of a highly non-linear system of partial differential equations define by themselves the very manifold on which they are supposed to exist. This is why a solution of Einstein's equations cannot be physically interpreted before its global behaviour is known, taking into account the entire hypothetical underlying manifold. In her youth, Yvonne Choquet-Bruhat contributed in a spectacular way to this domain stretching between physics and mathematics, when she gave the proof of the existence of solutions to Einstein's equations on differential manifolds of a quite general type. The methods she created have been worked out by the French school of mathematics, principally by Jean Leray. Her first proof of the local existence and uniqueness of solutions of Einstein's equations inspired Jean Leray's theory of general hyperbolic systems.

De que forma se dá o embate entre os Poderes do Estado em juízo, na hipótese de existir dúvida objetiva sobre a quem pertença determinada atribuição? A tutela judicial do sistema de freios e contrapesos, enquanto questão de mérito, torna-se necessária exatamente a partir do momento em que surge essa dúvida objetiva, ou mais precisamente o conflito de atribuição entre os Poderes do Estado. No Brasil, é antiga a prática judicial de solucionar conflito de atribuição entre Poderes do Estado como questão de mérito (questão principal), tendo sido objeto de nosso estudo especificamente a ação judicial respectiva, a que denominamos de ação de atribuição, e o processo por meio do qual ela é exercida, qual seja, o processo de atribuição. As trajetórias desses conflitos (de meros conflitos administrativos para conflitos de atribuição), do direito material pertinente (da hierarquia monárquica para a cláusula de "separação dos Poderes"), e do direito processual aplicável (de processo administrativo para jurisdicional, mais especificamente ação e processo de atribuição) são todas traçadas a partir da análise de documentos históricos obtidos em fontes oficiais, o que permitiu desenhar seus perfis desde o Conselho de Estado, no Brasil imperial, passando pelo período republicano, incluindo o golpe de 1964 e a redemocratização de 1988. Ao longo desses caminhos entremeados, revelou-se forte a correlação entre o regime político-constitucional praticado - autoritário ou democrático - e o tipo de conflito existente (meramente administrativo ou de atribuição entre Poderes distintos), o que impacta diretamente no campo processual. A partir desse quadro, procuramos responder: ainda há espaço e relevância para a ação de atribuição dentro sistema misto de controle de constitucionalidade estabelecido pela Constituição Federal de 1988? Quais os princípios e regras que regem a ação e o processo de atribuição?

In this book Steven Levine explores the relation between objectivity and experience from a pragmatic point of view. Like many new pragmatists he aims to rehabilitate objectivity in the wake of Richard Rorty's rejection of the concept. But he challenges the idea, put forward by pragmatists like Robert Brandom, that objectivity is best rehabilitated in communicative-theoretic terms - namely, in terms that can be cashed out by capacities that agents gain through linguistic communication. Levine proposes instead that objectivity is best understood in experiential-theoretic terms. He explains how, in order to meet the aims of the new pragmatists, we need to do more than see objectivity as a norm of rationality embedded in our social-linguistic practices; we also need to see it as emergent from our experiential interaction with the world. Innovative and carefully argued, this book redeems and re-actualizes for contemporary philosophy a key insight developed by the classical pragmatists.
