EC is a multi-tenant solution which makes it so that all customers are automatically on the latest release without having to go through costly and time consuming upgrades. The updates are delivered to customers on a quarterly basis which allows significant innovation in a short period. SAP SuccessFactor

s Employee Central Payroll (ECP) is a cloud based system used to process payroll that is directly integrated within EC. ECP uses the global and world class SAP HCM Payroll engine as the basis for payroll processing. ECP is hosted by SAP Cloud, so customers do not have to invest in expensive upfront hardware or take on the additional responsibilities of maintaining and securing

the system. This contributes directly to a lower total cost of ownership (TCO) when compared to on-premise payroll models and makes it a viable system for much smaller companies than those that used SAP HCM. Data is automatically replicated from EC to ECP and users can access payroll specific functions - including running payroll, updating payroll data,
