The French violin virtuoso Jacques Pierre Joseph Rode (1774-1830) was a favourite pupil of Giovanni Battista Viotti, whose concertos he often performed. Ludwig van Beethoven composed his final Violin Sonata for Rode. These 24 Caprices in all the keys were composed between 1814 and 1819 and have become a standard part of advanced violin study. This classic Edition Peters publication is an essential part of any advancing violinist's library.

Kalmus introduces two concertos to its catalog by Pierre Rode that are gems. Rarely found yet worthy of performance and study. Both violin and piano parts are included.

'The Austrian violinist Jacob Dont (1815-1888) was also a highly esteemed teacher and composer. He wrote mainly major educational works, over 50 of which have become quite well-known. Dont's 'Etüden und Capricen' Op. 35 were arranged for the viola by Max Rostal who also added preparatory exercises and variants. 'Etüden und Capricen' covers all technical demands with regard to arpeggios, double stops, dexterity, change of position, legato, change of string, types of bowing, trills and appoggiaturas, thus laying the foundation for practising any repertoire.

Beloved for his 32 Rose Etudes for Clarinet book, C. Rose -- full name Chrysogone Cyrille Rose was an important French clarinetist, and served as principal clarinet at the Paris Opera. He was a teacher and composer of pedagogical material for the clarinet, much of which (like this 32 Etudes) is still widely in use today. Cyrille Rose was taught by Hyacinthe Klosé. He studied under Klosé at the Paris Conservatoire, winning the First Prize in 1847. He taught many famous clarinet players, such as: Louis Cahuzac, Paul Jean, Manuel Gomez, Francisco Gomez, Henri Lefèbvre, Henri Paradis, Henri Selmer, and Alexandre Selmer.

Etudes and Caprices, Op. 35 Alfred Music
