Neonatal resuscitation is a procedure performed if a newborn infant does not start breathing spontaneously immediately after birth Neonatal resuscitation provides oxygen, stimulates breathing and gets the heart to start pumping normally A majority of babies start breathing on their own and need only routine neonatal care Approximately 10% of

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) for Infants Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (car dee oh PULL mon air ee ree SUS I TA shun) is a combination of chest pumping (compressions) which moves blood from the heart to the body, and mouth-to-mouth breathing which sends oxygen to the lungs
