Though they had many stars on their team, they relied more on spacing and ball movement to win games. This led to the current pace-and-space era where teams rely more on increasing the tempo of the game while spacing the floor with four or more shooters. This pace-and-space era led to the introduction of positionless basketball that demands all five players to bring the ball up, make plays for others, and shoot the ball from the perimeter. You are now seeing frontcourt players 6'7" or taller spacing the floor with their three-point shooting or even playing the point from time to time. Answers are however NOT included, so adult support and involvement with the completion of the workbook is recommended. For teachers, this would be a matter of

course in the classroom anyway (and you will find that the answers are not too tricky to find), and for parents, it is often an enjoyable thing to have a project to work on with your child, and to get an idea of where they are with questions which are aimed towards a Year Three curriculum.
