Seit einigen Jahrzehnten kennt das öffentliche Recht das "Stoffrecht", seit mehreren Jahrhunderten kennt das Patentrecht den "Stoffschutz", viele weitere Normen, z. B. des Straf-, Zivil- und Welthandelsrechts kennen heute den naturwissenschaftlich geprägten Begriff "Stoff" - doch seine Bedeutung im Recht wurde bisher kaum naher untersucht. Diese Besonderheit durfte in dem Umstand begründet sein, dass mit dem "Stoff" nicht weniger als ein neues Weltbild in das

Recht eingezogen ist, nämlich das naturwissenschaftlich-materialistische Weltbild. Dieser Umstand wirft schwerwiegende, u. a. rechtsphilosophische und rechtstheoretische Folgefragen auf, denen sich die Rechtswissenschaft bisher kaum angenommen hat. Letztlich scheint der Einzug des Stoffbegriffs in das Recht demselben nicht weniger abzuverlangen, als die Ermöglichung einer sinnvollen Koexistenz verschiedener Sichtweisen auf die Welt. Die Arbeit wurde mit dem Baker McKenzie Preis 2018 der Universität Frankfurt/Main ausgezeichnet.

Friedrich Hölderlin's only novel, *Hyperion* (1797-99), is a fictional epistolary autobiography that juxtaposes narration with critical reflection. Returning to Greece after German exile, following his part in the abortive uprising against the occupying Turks (1770), and his failure as both a lover and a revolutionary, *Hyperion* assumes a hermitic existence, during which he writes his letters. Confronting and commenting on his own past, with all its joy and grief, the narrator undergoes a transformation that culminates in the realisation of his true vocation. Though Hölderlin is now established as a great lyric poet, recognition of his novel as a supreme

achievement of European Romanticism has been belated in the Anglophone world. Incorporating the aesthetic evangelism that is a characteristic feature of the age, *Hyperion* preaches a message of redemption through beauty. The resolution of the contradictions and antinomies raised in the novel is found in the act of articulation itself. To a degree remarkable in a prose work of any length, what it means is inseparable from how it means. Die Ergebnisse aus der Untersuchung werden im vierten Kapitel diskutiert. An Hand der Schrift wird versucht, Antworten auf folgende Fragen zu finden: - Hat die Re-Inszenierung der "Landshuter Hochzeit 1475" des 21. In the past 20 years micronutrients have assumed great public health importance and a considerable amount of

research has led to increasing knowledge of their physiological role. Because it is a rapidly developing field, the WHO and FAO convened an Expert Consultation to evaluate the current state of knowledge. It had three main tasks: to review the full scope of vitamin and minerals requirements; to draft and adopt a report which would provide recommended nutrient intakes for vitamins A, C, D, E, and K; the B vitamins; calcium; iron; magnesium; zinc; selenium; and iodine; to identify key issues for future research and make preliminary recommendations for the handbook. The End and the Beginning Lawrence Hill Books

This is the first full-scale biography, in any language, of a towering figure in German and European Romanticism: August Wilhelm Schlegel whose life, 1767 to 1845, coincided with its inexorable rise. As poet, translator, critic and oriental scholar, Schlegel's extraordinarily diverse interests and

writings left a vast intellectual legacy, making him a foundational figure in several branches of knowledge. He was one of the last thinkers in Europe able to practise as well as to theorise, and to attempt to comprehend the nature of culture without being forced to be a narrow specialist. With his brother Friedrich, for example, Schlegel edited the avant-garde Romantic periodical *Athenaeum*; and he produced with his wife Caroline a translation of Shakespeare, the first metrical version into any foreign language. Schlegel's *Lectures on Dramatic Art and Literature* were a defining force for Coleridge and for the French Romantics. But his interests extended to French, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese literature, as well to the Greek and Latin classics, and to Sanskrit. August Wilhelm Schlegel is the first attempt to engage with this totality, to combine an account of Schlegel's life and times with a critical evaluation of his work and its influence. Through the study of one man's rich life, incorporating the most recent scholarship, theoretical approaches, and archival resources,

while remaining easily accessible to all readers, Paulin has recovered the intellectual climate of Romanticism in Germany and traced its development into a still-potent international movement. The extraordinarily wide scope and variety of Schlegel's activities have hitherto acted as a barrier to literary scholars, even in Germany. In Roger Paulin, whose career has given him the knowledge and the experience to grapple with such an ambitious project, Schlegel has at last found a worthy exponent.
