An adverb can modify complete sentences, subordinate clauses, and prepositional phrases However, its main purpose is to modify a verb, another adverb, or an adjective For instance, in the sentence, "He was eloquently drunk, lovingly and pugnaciously drunk" (Elmer Gantry, by Sinclair Lewis), the underlined adverbs are modifying the adjective

Adjectives and adverbs describe things For example, compare the phrase "the bear" to "the red bear" or the phrase "run" to "run slowly " In both of these cases, the adjective (red) or adverb (slowly) changes how we understand the phrase When you first read the word bear, you probably didn't imagine a red bear
