When robbing my forehead, I discovered its bone was very soft like the thigh flesh. And wonder how the bone was soft like flesh. I then asked him what he said which I did not hear clearly. Then the assistant that was standing by Him said, "He said, Mathew 3:2, go and write and preach." Mathew 3:2 says "Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" The challenge and the burden in the heart of God for this moment is the

decay that is evidently clear and seen in the Church, and the world today, hence the need for a genuine repentance in the Church and the world at large "Whom shall I send, And who will go for us"? (Isaiah 6:8)
