The method involved preconcentration by anion exchange of Au complexed with cyanide ion and detection by flow injection-inductively coupled plasma quadrupole mass spectrometry (FI-ICPMS). An aliquot of a radiotracer was added to each sample to monitor recoveries. Analysis by FI-ICPMS resulted in a practical detection limit, expressed as the concentration of Au in seawater, of about 10 fmo/liter for a four liter preconcentrate. Corrections for the stable Au in the radiotracer and that contributed by reagents were significant, constituting up to 60% of the overall signals measured. Reproducibility, based in the analyses of five four-liter samples of Mediterranean seawater obtained from a single 30-liter Niskin bottle, was about 15% at the 140 fmo/liter level. Gold profiles from the Atlantic Gulf Stream, Northeast Pacific, Mediterranean and Black Seas and hydrothermal fluids from 21 N, on the East Pacific Rise were analyzed. In general, the concentrations of Au in seawater are nearly three orders of magnitude less than reported in the literature prior to 1988. Gold is a non-conservative element in seawater. It does not appear to undergo appreciable recycling in the water column under oxic conditions as is evidenced by its fairly homogeneous distribution over the water column and similar average values in the Atlantic. **Microbial Degradation of Tauropine. An investigation** World Scientific

No nuclear weapon has ever been detonated in a United States city. However, this also means the nuclear forensic community has no actual debris from which to develop analytical methods for source attribution, making the development of surrogate nuclear debris a vital undertaking. Moreover, the development of marine-urban debris presents an unusual challenge because unlike soil and urban structures, which remain compositionally consistent, the elemental composition of harbor and port waters fluctuates considerably due to natural phenomenon and human activity. Additionally, marine vessel composition and cargo can vary dramatically. While early US nuclear tests were carried out in shallow-water coastal areas, they did not represent the marine-urban environments of large cities and any residual debris will be ill suited for the development of modern forensic techniques. Given these technical complexities, it is critical to understand the environmental variations in order to develop realistic surrogate nuclear marine-urban debris. This project seeks to build a robust model for the New York/New Jersey harbor, the Port of Houston, and the Long Beach/Los Angeles harbor that statistically define the elemental composition of vaporized debris for follow-on neutron-activation and debris formation analysis. Analysis of these neutron and fractionation effects will support the development of unique surrogate debris samples that mimic the elemental content of actual nuclear debris from a marin-urban detonation. These samples can then be utilized for the development of the analytical methods for post-detonation analysis and attribution.

Internship Report from the year 2015 in the subject Chemistry - Bio-chemistry, grade: 1.0, University of Constance, language: English, abstract: One interesting aspect is the involvement and the relevance of one sole enzyme in the microbial tauropine degradation pathway: the tauropine dehydrogenase. Therefore three main questions were studied. The first was to verify the action of a tauropine dehydrogenase in microorganisms. The second step was to further characterize this enzyme by its molecular weight and its localization within bacterial cells. In addition, the degradation pathway downstream of the potential tauropine dehydrogenase should be clarified. Therefore, in this study, the metabolism of tauropine in four different model organisms was investigated. As model organisms a *Ralstonia* strain from fresh water was used and in addition three terrestrial bacterial strains were isolated. The metabolism of tauropine in microorganisms is not yet clarified. Tauropine, besides other opines, has also been reported in the context of bacteria. In fact, it was found in plants, which were infected by agrobacteria with a virulent Ti plasmid. The resulting genetic modification leads to tumor formation, and the plant is triggered to produce opines. As plants cannot use opines themselves, the opines serve as nutrition for the agrobacteria and other opine-degrading bacterial strains. But so far, compared to marine animal

phyla, the intermediate steps in the degradation of tauroopine in microorganisms are widely unknown. Preliminary investigation in marine bacteria like *Ruegeria pomeroyi* DSS-3 and *Roseovarius nubinhibens* ISM has shown that they can use tauroopine as source of carbon and nitrogen. Sulfate thereby occurs as end product. It is possible, that the tauroopine degradation in bacteria is analogous to that in invertebrates. This would mean that a dehydrogenase is involved. If in microorganisms tauroopine can be degraded into pyruvate and taurine by a tauroopine dehydrogenase, it is also possible that taurine is further metabolized in the processes, which are already quite well understood. Those processes could include the taurine dehydrogenase and desulfonation by sulfoacetaldehyde acetyltransferase.

Finally, this edition incorporates amendments to the Supplementary Materials accompanying the MCM as published in the Federal Register on December 11, 2018.
