Interviewer Fernando
Sorrentino, an Argentinian
writer and anthologist, is
endowed with literary
acumen, sensitivity,

urbanity, and an
encyclopedic memory of
Jorge Luis Borges' work (in
his prologue, Borges jokes
that Sorrentino knows his
work "much better than I
do"). Borges wanders
from nostalgic
reminiscence to literary
criticism, and from
philosophical speculation
to political
pronouncements. His
thoughts on literature
alone run the gamut from
the Bible and Homer to
Ernest Hemingway and
Julio Cortázar. We learn
that Dante is the writer
who has impressed
Borges most, that Borges
considers Federico García
Lorca to be a "second-rate
poet," and that he feels
Adolfo Bioy Casares is one
of the most important
authors of this century.
Borges dwells lovingly on

Buenos Aires, too. From
the preface: For seven
afternoons, the teller of
tales preceded me,
opening tall doors which
revealed unsuspected
spiral staircases, through
the National Library's
pleasant maze of
corridors, in search of a
secluded little room
where we would not be
interrupted by the
telephone...The Borges
who speaks to us in this
book is a courteous, easy-
going gentleman who
verifies no quotations,
who does not look back to
correct mistakes, who
pretends to have a poor
memory; he is not the
terse Jorge Luis Borges of
the printed page, that
Borges who calculates
and measures each
comma and each
parenthesis. Sorrentino

and translator Clark M. Zlotchew have included an appendix on the Latin American writers mentioned by Borges *Wortkunst, Erzählkunst, Bildkunst* Erich Schmidt Verlag GmbH & Co KG Vols. for 1948/50- issued in two parts: 1. Autoren und Anonymenreihe, Stichwörter (varies slightly) -- 2. Schlagwortreihe (varies slightly) Verzeichnis lieferbarer Bücher V&R Unipress Das Deutsche Literatur-Lexikon. Das 20. Jahrhundert ist die Fortführung und Ergänzung des Deutschen Literatur-Lexikons. AutorInnen des deutschsprachigen Raumes sind verzeichnet, sofern ihr maßgebliches Wirken im 20. Jahrhundert liegt. Die Artikel enthalten Namen, Lebensdaten und eine Kurzbiographie. Im bibliographischen Teil werden Schriften, Übersetzungen, Herausgeber-tigkeit, Briefe, Nachlass, etc. wie auch die Sekundärliteratur verzeichnet. *Deeg - Dürrenfeld* University of North Texas Press Aufzählungen finden sich in der modernen Literatur außerordentlich häufig, z.B. bei Flaubert, Joyce,

Borges, Proust... Sie gehören aber auch quer durch die Geschichte und die Kulturen zur Literatur überhaupt; man denke an Homer, die Bibel, Sei Shonagon, Rabelais, Swift... Ihre konkreten Gestalten sind Inventar, Litanei, Gesetzestafel, Beschreibung, Rezept, Fragebogen, Chronik u.a. Die Arbeit versucht weder eine Geschichte noch eine Typologie des Aufzählens zu bieten, sondern stellt die Frage 'How to do things with lists?' anhand von Texten verschiedenster Art. Sie zeigt die vielfältigen Funktionen und die besondere Wandlungsfähigkeit dieses schlichten Sprachmodus. Der Schwerpunkt liegt auf der Literatur nach dem Verfall der traditionellen Katalogtopoi. Neben Fragen der Rhetorik und Poetik kommen Probleme der Wissenschaftsgeschichte und Medialität zur Sprache. **Johann Georg Hamann, Autor und Autorschaft** Woodbridge, Conn. : Research Publications, Incorporated Friedrich Nietzsche's influence on the development of modern social sciences has not been well documented.

Dem Kolloquium von 1992 ging es um Autor und Autorschaft - einen Bereich, der für Hamann Vorstellungen wie «Gott als Schriftsteller», die Schöpfung als Schrift, aber auch die Umsetzung solcher Bilder in eine Fundamentalkritik an der zeitgenössischen Literatur, Philosophie und Theologie beinhaltet.

Hamanns Wirkung hält an und überschreitet die fachlichen und nationalen Grenzen. So wurden diesmal die Hamann-Rezeption und Hamann-Forschung im russischen Sprachbereich behandelt und neue Beziehungen zur Universität Königsberg geknüpft, von der Hamann ausgegangen war.

In dieser Aufsatzsammlung wird Johann Georg Hamanns Grundthese von »Gott als Schriftsteller« interpretiert und in weitreichende literarische Zusammenhänge gestellt. Das Verhältnis von Reden, Hören und Sehen wird theologisch und eschatologisch untersucht. Hamanns Gedanken zum Abendmahl und zum »Sacrament der Sprache« werden mit der Rolle des Essens und Trinkens in Beziehung gebracht. Die Narziss-Episode der »Metamorphosen« des Ovid deutete Hamann christologisch und als

Kenner des Hebräerbriefs verfasste er eine kritische Rezension des Kommentars von J. D. Michaelis (Göttingen). Joachim Ringleben arbeitet die Bedeutung Hamanns als des maßgeblichen theologischen Sprachdenkers nach Luther heraus, dessen Worttheologie u. a. Kierkegaard geprägt hat. In this essay collection Johann Georg Hamann's thesis of »God as author« is interpreted and put into a wider literary context.

The relationship between speaking, hearing and seeing is examined in a theological and eschatological manner. Hamann's idea on the last supper and on the »Sacrament of speech« are put into a relationship with the importance of eating and drinking. The Narcissus episode of Ovid's » Metamorphoses« were interpreted by Hamann in a christological manner. As a connoisseur of the Hebrews, he wrote a critical review on the

comment of Johann David Michaelis (Göttingen School of History). Joachim Ringleben analyses the meaning of Hamann as an of the most important theological thinkers after Luther, whose speech theology influenced Kierkegaard among others.
