It was among the most notorious criminal cases of its day. On August 11, 1921, in Birmingham, Alabama, a Methodist minister named Edwin Stephenson shot and killed a Catholic priest, James Coyle, in broad daylight and in front of numerous witnesses. The killer's motive? The priest had married Stephenson's

eighteen-year-old daughter Ruth to Pedro Gussman, a Puerto Rican migrant and practicing Catholic. Sharon Davies's *Rising Road* resurrects the murder of Father Coyle and the trial of his killer. As Davies reveals with novelistic richness, Stephenson's crime laid bare the most potent bigotries of the age: a hatred not only of blacks, but of Catholics and "foreigners" as well. In one of the case's most unexpected turns, the minister hired future U.S. Supreme Court Justice

Hugo Black to lead his defense. Though regarded later in life as a civil rights champion, in 1921 Black was just months away from donning the robes of the Ku Klux Klan, the secret order that financed Stephenson's defense. Entering a plea of temporary insanity, Black defended the minister on claims that the Catholics had robbed Ruth away from her true Protestant faith, and that her Puerto Rican husband was actually black. Placing the story in social and historical context, Davies

brings this heinous crime and its aftermath back to life, in a brilliant and engrossing examination of the wages of prejudice and a trial that shook the nation at the height of Jim Crow. This conflict is then more striking as it was a conscious decision of the organizers of the workshop to focus attention on what might broadly be called liberal democracies: those societies which share a commitment to the principles of democratic

participation, to the right of equal concern and respect of all members of the community, and to the basic liberties of association, expression, and thought. Ours was not the smug premise, however, that every society which proclaims these principles is sufficiently or even truly devoted to them. But we did assume that we would have enough to do if we explored the implications of these widely shared ideals for the topic of linguistic, ethnic, and national minorities as

these problems arise in societies where an appeal to them is not an empty gesture. The nations from which our participants were drawn are societies in which appeal to these principles has some point. They are all societies in which the efforts of politicians and the intelligence of scholars need not be devoted exclusively to the tactical issues of winning some modicum of respect for basic human rights from unwilling regimes. And yet all these societies have experienced significant

difficulty in determining what the concrete meaning in actual situations of these general principles might be.

 Amerindian societies have an iconic status in classical political thought. For Montaigne, Hobbes, Locke, Hume and Rousseau, the native American 'state of nature' operates as a foil for the European polity. Challenging this tradition, *The Imbalance of Power* demonstrates ethnographically that the Carib speaking indigenous societies of the Guiana region of Amazonia do not fit conventional characterizations of

'simple' political units with 'egalitarian' political ideologies and 'harmonious' relationships with nature. Marc Brightman builds a persuasive and original theory of Amerindian politics: far from balanced and egalitarian, Carib societies are rife with tension and difference; but this imbalance conditions social dynamism and a distinctive mode of cohesion. *The Imbalance of Power* is based on the author's fieldwork in partnership with Vanessa

Le Fils de Dieu reste par nature unique dans l'humanité ; ses actes, ses pensées, ses paroles ont été uniques, et nul être humain ne peut prétendre à leur originalité. L'imitation de Dieu que nous exhorte l'Écriture à exercer ne peut donc consister en un simple mimétisme dicté par notre imagination. Savoir

ce que Jésus ferait à notre place, ne peut correspondre à une réalité que si son Esprit nous anime.
