The pagination and layout of the vocal score match the old Spicker edition, so you can use the two of them together without confusion.

In this groundbreaking book, Michael Gorman asks why there is no theory or model of the atonement called the "new-covenant" model, since this understanding of the atonement is likely the earliest in the Christian tradition, going back to Jesus himself. The first performance of Handel's 'Messiah' in Dublin in 1742 is now legendary.
