southern Siberia to study with traditional Buryat shamans. Her first book, *Riding Windhorses*, provided an introduction to the shamanic world of Siberia. *Chosen by the Spirits* delves more deeply into the personal relationship between the shamanic student and his or her "spirit family." Sarangerel recounts her own journey into shamanic practice and provides the serious student with practical advice and hands-on techniques for recognizing and acknowledging a shamanic calling, welcoming and embodying the spirits, journeying to the spirit world, and healing both people and places.
