Die Zuwanderung nach Deutschland hat seit der Grenzöffnung im September 2015 eine neue Dimension erreicht. Aus in Auflösung begriffenen Staaten kommen überwiegend muslimische Migranten als "neue Deutsche" in die Gesellschaft derer, "die schon länger hier leben" (Angela Merkel). Die Politik bietet Rhetorik und Durchhalteparolen – von der "Willkommenskultur" über "Wir schaffen das" bis zu "Fluchtursachen bekämpfen" –, hat aber weder ein schlüssiges Konzept für den Umgang mit den Flüchtlingsströmen noch für eine echte Integration der Zuwanderer. Bassam Tibi, selbst syrischer Migrant, analysiert sachorientiert und kundig die Faktenlage. Integration, so zeigt er auf, ist etwas anderes als ein Zurschaustellen von Fremdenliebe, verbunden mit Unterbringung, Alimentierung und Sprachkursen. Integration erfordert vor allem das Angebot einer inklusiven Bürgeridentität des Aufnahmelandes und einer Annahme dieses Angebots durch Neuankömmlinge – nur so kann sich ein sense of belonging einstellen, ein Zugehörigkeitsgefühl und eine Identifizierung mit der Aufnahmegesellschaft und ihren Werten. Doch spätestens an diesem essentiellen Punkt versagt die deutsche Migrationspolitik vollständig und mit katastrophalen Konsequenzen, und das nicht erst seit 2015. Viele hier lebende Muslime haben ein akutes Identitätsproblem – eine der Hauptursachen für religiöse Radikalisierung und Ablehnung der Aufnahmegesellschaft bis hin zu einer offen feindseligen Haltung ihr gegenüber. Tibi arbeitet

eindringlich die Gefahren und Folgen heraus, die mit einem Scheitern des aktuell stattfindenden Großexperiments Zuwanderung verbunden sind, und bietet gleichzeitig eine scharfsinnige Analyse der Situation in den derzeit besonders problematischen Herkunftsstaaten.

He summarizes the history of the peninsula from the Vietnamese War of Independence from China in 930-39 through the first French military actions in 1858, when the struggle of the peoples of Indochina with Western powers began. Dommen details the crucial episodes in the colonization of Indochina by the French and the indigenous reaction to it. The struggle for national sovereignty reached an acute state at the end of World War II, when independent governments rapidly assumed power in Vietnam and Cambodia. When the French returned, the struggle became one of open warfare, with Nationalists and Communists gripped in a contest for ascendancy in Vietnam, while the rulers of Cambodia and Laos sought to obtain independence by negotiation. The withdrawal of the French after their defeat at Dien Bien Phu brought the Indochinese face-to-face, whether as friends or as enemies, with the Americans. In spite of an armistice in 1954, the war between Hanoi and Saigon resumed as each enlisted the help of foreign allies, which led to the renewed loss of sovereignty as a result of alliances and an increasingly heavy loss of lives. Meticulous and detailed, Dommen's telling of this complicated story is always judicious. Nevertheless, many people will find his analysis of the Diem coup a disturbing account of American plotting and murder. This is an essential book for anyone who wants to understand Vietnam and the people who fought against the United States and won.

My War with the CIA Arcade Publishing

The political history of Cambodia between 1945 and 1979, which culminated in the devastating revolutionary excesses of the Pol Pot regime, is one of unrest and misery. This book by David P. Chandler is the first to give a full account of this tumultuous period. Drawing on his experience as a foreign service officer in Phnom Penh, on interviews, and on archival material. Chandler considers why the revolution happened and how it was related to Cambodia's earlier history and to other events in Southeast Asia. He describes Cambodia's brief spell of independence from Japan after the end of World War II; the long and complicated rule of Norodom Sihanouk, during which the Vietnam War gradually spilled over Cambodia's borders; the bloodless coup of 1970 that deposed Sihanouk and put in power the feeble, pro-American government of Lon Nol; and the revolution in 1975 that ushered in the radical changes and horrors of Pol Pot's Communist regime. Chandler discusses how Pol Pot and his colleagues evacuated Cambodia's cities and towns, transformed its seven million people into an unpaid labor force, tortured and killed party members when agricultural quotas were unmet, and were finally overthrown in the course of a Vietnamese military invasion in 1979. His book is a penetrating and poignant analysis of this fierce revolutionary period and the events of the previous quarter-century that made it possible.

Autodafé dello spirito è la testimonianza dell’impegno civile e politico di Joseph Roth durante gli anni dell’esilio, dal 1933 al 1939. È il grido d’allarme di un intellettuale che non vuole cedere alla follia criminale che lo circonda, ma vede chiaramente il baratro verso il quale la Germani nazista sta trascinando l’Europa. Attraverso questi articoli, alcuni dei quali tradotti per la prima volta in italiano, possiamo ricostruire le urgenze e gli sviluppi del pensiero dello scrittore: il suo scivolare dall’iniziale socialismo verso posizioni monarchiche (ma sempre in chiave antifascista), la rivendicazione dell’erranza ebraica (contrapposta al sionismo e alla ricerca di una patria geografica), la difesa dei valori umanistici della cultura europea. Mentre descrive i roghi di libri, l’abbruttimento della propaganda e le colpevoli esitazioni delle democrazie, la scrittura di Roth oscilla tra il sarcasmo, la disperazione e improvvisi slanci di speranza, ma la sua visione rimane lucida fino alla fine. Fino all’ultimo articolo, pubblicato il giorno prima del ricovero in ospedale, dove l’ombra dei campi di concentramento invade il simulacro svuotato di senso della cultura tedesca: «La quercia di Goethe a Buchenwald».
