Topeng Nusantara Yayasan Obor Indonesia

Wayang merupakan bentuk kesenian yang mencakupi drama, sastra, musik, tari, dan seni rupa. Di samping multi seni, wayang juga dipandang sebagai multi dimensi, karena selain estetis, juga mengandung muatan filosofis, makna simbolis, sebagai gambaran kehidupan manusia, bertalian dengan etika dan pesan moral, serta keteladanan. Sebagai bagian dari kebudayaan Nusantara yang hidup sejak ratusan tahun yang lalu dan mendapat pengakuan dunia, perlu kiranya nilai-nilai yang terdapat di dalamnya diwariskan ke generasi muda. Sejumlah tokoh dengan wataknya masing-masing, tergambar dengan jelas dalam balutan ceritera yang bersumber dari wiracarita Mahabharata dan Ramayana. Wayang kulit purwa berkembang subur di Jawa dan Bali. Buku ini lebih memfokuskan seni rupa wayang kulit purwa Jawa. Pada bagian pertama, dibahas mengenai asal usul dan perkembangan wayang, termasuk

pengertian dan jenis-jenisnya. Bagian kedua dikemukakan kisah singkat wiracarita Mahabharata dan Ramayana, yang menjadi sumber lakon-lakon pertunjukan wayang serta berisi tokoh-tokoh penting yang terdapat di dalamnya. Bagian ketiga diketengahkan bentuk perupa-an tokoh-tokoh penting itu dalam gambar wayang kulit. Bagian keempat mengajak pembaca untuk mengapresiasi keindahan wayang kulit yang ditatah tembus dan disungging dengan warna. The Hindu pantheon is rich in images of the divine feminine—deities representing a wide range of symbolic, social, and meditative meanings. David Kinsley's new book documents a highly unusual group of ten Hindu tantric goddesses, the Mahavidyas, many of whom are strongly associated with sexuality and violence. What is one to make of a goddess who cuts her own head off, or one who prefers sex with a corpse? The Mahavidyas embody habits, attributes, or identities usually considered repulsive or socially subversive and can be viewed as "antimodels" for women. Yet it is within the context of tantric worship that devotees seek to identify themselves with these forbidding goddesses. The Mahavidyas seem to function as "awakeners"—symbols which help to project one's consciousness beyond the socially acceptable or predictable. Drawing on a broad range of Sanskrit and vernacular texts as well as extensive

research in India, including written and oral interpretations of contemporary Hindu practitioners, Kinsley describes the unusual qualities of each of the Mahavidyas and traces the parallels between their underlying themes. Especially valuable are the many rare and fascinating images he presents—each important to grasping the significance of the goddesses. Written in an accessible, engaging style, Kinsley's book provides a comprehensive understanding of the Mahavidyas and is also an overview of Hindu tantric practice.

This volume is the result of a conference held in October 2015 in connection with the Frankfurt Book Fair discussing developments that are considered important in contemporary Indonesian cultural productions. The first part of the book reflects on the traumatic experiences of the Indonesian nation caused by a failed coup on October 1, 1965. In more general theoretical terms, this topic connects to the field of memory studies, which, in recent decades, has made an academic comeback. The focus of the chapters in this section is how certain, often distressing, events are represented in narratives in a variety of media that are periodically renewed, changed, rehearsed, repeated, and performed, in order to become or stay part of the collective memory of a certain group of people. The second part of the book explores how forces of globalisation have impacted upon the local and, linguistically surprisingly, rather homogeneous cultural

productions of Indonesia. The main strands of inquiry in this second section are topics of global trends in religion, responses to urban development, the impact of popular literary developments, and how traditions are revisited in order to come to terms with international cultural developments.
