The Corsair affair has  
been called the "most

renowned controversy  
in Danish literary  
history." At the center  
is Søren Kierkegaard,  
whose pseudonymous  
Stages on Life's Way  
occasioned a frivolous  
and dishonorable  
review by Peder Ludvig  
Møller. Møller was  
associated with The

Corsair, a publication notorious for gossip and caricature. The editor was Meir Goldschmidt, an acquaintance of Kierkegaard's and an admirer of his early work. Kierkegaard struck back at not only Møller and Goldschmidt but at the paper as a whole. The present volume contains all of the documents relevant to this dispute, plus a historical introduction that recapitulates the sequence of events surrounding the controversy. Parts I (Article) and II (Addenda) contain articles both signed by and attributed to Kierkegaard in response to the affair. A supplement includes writings pertaining to the Corsair affair by Goldschmidt and

Møller, as well as unpublished pieces by Kierkegaard from his journals and papers. Although the immediate occasion was literary, for Kierkegaard the issues as well as the consequences were ethical, social, philosophical, and religious. Howard Hong argues that the most important consequence was wholly unexpected and unintended: the second phase of Kierkegaard's authorship.

As a brief and suggestive commentary on the New Testament, the *Gnomon* is still of considerable use today. Bengel's chief principle of interpretation, briefly stated, is to read nothing into the Scriptures, but to draw everything from them, and suffer nothing to remain hidden that is really in them. His *Gnomon* exerted considerable influence on exegesis in Germany, and John Wesley translated most

 Orders of Knighthood,  
 Honours and Awards,  
 including Foreign  
 Orders, by the non-  
 effective officer list and  
 the War Services of  
 officers of the Indian  
 Army. Details of each

officer include dates of  
 birth (except for  
 wartime commissioned  
 officers), date of first  
 commission, of  
 appointment to the  
 Indian Army and dates  
 of promotion. Officers  
 are grouped according  
 to their rank and by  
 seniority within that  
 rank, and are again  
 shown under their  
 regiments/battalions.  
 In the case of British  
 units, their date of  
 arrival in India is  
 shown, and with Indian  
 units their date of  
 formation and changes  
 in title since, plus  
 details of the  
 backgrounds of men  
 recruited, e.g. Sikhs,  
 Punjabis, Dogras,  
 Rajputs, etc. This army  
 list also includes all  
 native Viceroy  
 Commissioned Officers  
 - Subadar Majors,  
 Subadars and  
 Jemadars - and their

war services, Major HQs and their staffs, divisional and brigade commanders and their staffs, schools, colleges, Administrative Departments of the Army are all shown. Non-regular Indian Defence Force units such as 22nd Bengal and North-Western railway Battalion, and the Indian Army Reserve of Officers are all there, along with British Warrant Officers serving in departments

of the Indian Army. In 1914 there were 116 Indian and 10 Gurkha Regiments, all with one battalion apart from the cavalry, 32 Indian and one Gurkha regiment had been formed and the majority of the original regiments had raised second and sometimes third battalions.
