Ce "roman" est , par son contenu, son volume et sa forme, un ouvrage si extravagant, si unique en on genre, qu'il convient d'en rappeler brièvement la généalogie. Au début des années 1970, Serge Doubrovsky commença la rédaction d'un ouvrage monumental qui, selon son auteur, devait jeter les bases théoriques de ce qui sera plus tard défini comme « autofiction ». Une fois achevé,

ce manuscrit comptait près de 3000 pages et aucun éditeur ne consentit à le publier en l'état. Une partie, réaménagée, réduite à 450 pages, de ce livre parut néanmoins en 1977, sous le titre de Fils, après quoi son auteur dispersa aux quatre coins du monde le manuscrit non publié. Isabelle Grell, chercheuse et spécialiste de l'œuvre de Serge Doubrovsky, entreprit de rassembler pieusement ces pages, de recomposer le tapuscrit originel qui, augmenté d'une double préface, est publié ici. L'aspect torrentueux de ce "texte retrouvé" rendait délicate une publication classique: Grasset a donc choisi de reproduire ce manuscrit, tel quel, et ce parti-pris éditorial a semblé d'autant plus légitime qu'il est en affinité avec le projet littéraire de Serge

Doubrovsky. Voici donc, à l'état brut, un texte craché, originel, véhément – rigoureusement fidèle aux stratégies de l'autofiction.

A basic theme of this report is that early school experience is probably the most important stage in a child's educational career. The emphasis is on the acquisition and use of language at home and in the primary school. Comprised of seven chapters, this book seeks to clarify everyday school decisions made by school personnel based on the child's performances in particular classroom and testing situations that influence his/her educational career early in life. The discussion begins by focusing on the placement of students in two kindergarten classes in two southern California school districts. More

specifically, the chapter examines the practices used by teachers to assign students to classes having particular characteristics; to place them in ability groups within classes; and to promote them to the next grade. Subsequent chapters explore how teachers accomplish classroom lessons; intelligence testing as a social activity; standardized tests as objective/objectified measures of a child's "competence" in school; and tests and experiments with children. The final chapter outlines some basic theoretical issues in the assessment of the child's performance in testing and classroom settings. This monograph will be a valuable resource for educators, sociologists, and psychologists.

La Révolution surréaliste

The French writer Raymond Queneau (1903-1976) is coming to be recognized as one of the major voices in 20th-century literature. Although twelve of his novels have been translated, *Chêne et Chien*, considered by specialists to be the keystone of his oeuvre, has not until now been available in English. Labeled a «novel in verse» by Queneau, this autobiographical poem recounts the
