ASQ/ANSI/ISO 9001:2015: Quality management systems - Requirements

Organizations certified to the ISO 9001:2008 standard will have a three-year period to transition to ISO 9001:2015. When the transition period ends in September 2018, ISO 9001:2008 certificates will no longer be valid. This International Standard specifies requirements for a quality management system when an organization:

There are now seven principles instead of the eight in the 2008 revision, but the essence is the same. The new version has 10 instead of the eight clauses in the old version, and instead of six

mandatory procedures, there are now six mandatory documents that don't have to be in the form of a procedure.

Although commonly referred to as "ISO 9000" certification, the actual standard to which an organization's quality management system can be certified is ISO 9001:2015 (ISO 9001:2008 expired around September 2018).
