A comprehensive treatment of the birds of the genus *Saxicola*. The genus *Saxicola* contains about 13 species, depending on taxonomy. They are a distinctive and popular group of birds, and include two very familiar and attractive British species - the Stonechat and Whinchat. This volume is primarily an identification guide, using colour plates and photographs to illustrate the various races and plumages, but the text also covers the biology, habitat and range of each species. DNA data is presented, and there are distribution maps for each species.

Some of the world's largest and most spectacular birds are to be found among this group of wading birds. Tragically, they also include many of the world's most endangered species, as changes in land use erode their wetland habitats. Some like the White Stork have lived alongside humans for hundreds of years and are well known from numerous studies. Others, like the Storm's stork and ibises of West Africa, South-East Asia and South America live so secluded a life in the remote corners of the globe that they will probably be extinct before even the most basic details of their biology are known. In this monograph, three authors and two artists have combined their skills to capture what is known of this group of wading birds. The text opens with general chapters on taxonomy and feeding, breeding and behavior, followed by detailed coverage of

each species. Während in vielen Alpengebieten die traditionelle Kulturlandschaft durch Verstädterung und Industrialisierung in Gefahr ist, erobert sich auf der Südabdachung des Alpenbogens die Natur ganze Landschaften zurück. Gleichzeitig gewinnt in der naturschutzfachlichen Diskussion die Forderung nach unbeeinflusster Naturdynamik und «Wildnis» im Kontrast zu den statisch konservierenden Managementkonzepten zunehmend an Bedeutung. In einem transdisziplinären Forschungsansatz untersuchten die Autoren die ökologischen und sozialen Folgen von Entsiedelung, Verbrachung und ungelentker Landschaftsdynamik an zwei vom Rückzug des Menschen geprägten Gebieten in den Alpen des Piemont (Italien): - am Val Grande-Nationalpark westlich des Lago Maggiore zwischen dem Ossolatal sowie dem Vigezzo- bzw. Cannobinatal gelegen, 1992 als Wildnisgebiet eingerichtet, und - am Stronatal, einem kurzen Tal, das vom Ortasee in Richtung des Monte Rosa-Massivs führt. Die beiden im oberen Talabschnitt gelegenen Dörfer werden heute nur noch im Sommer bewohnt, die Landwirtschaft ist stark rückläufig. Das Buch beschreibt Methoden und Ergebnisse der historischen und vegetationsökologischen Landschaftsanalyse und gibt Meinungsumfragen unter Bewohnern, Almhirten, Touristen und Politikern wieder. Auf dieser Grundlage diskutieren die Autoren das Spannungsfeld von Kulturlandschaft und «Wildnis» und unterziehen das Naturschutzleitbild «Wildnis» einer kritischen Analyse.
