In a total of three notebooks preserved today, Ana died in the Bergen-Belsen camp in March 1945. After her death, Ana became world famous thanks to the diary she wrote.

Anne Frank: Frankfurt-sur-le-Main, 12 June 1929-Bergen-Belsen, February 1945. The Diary of Anne Frank, her private diary, where she recorded the almost two and a half years she spent in hiding, with her family and four other people, from the Nazis, in Amsterdam during World War II. Once they were discovered in their hiding place, Ana and her family were captured and taken to different German concentration camps.

The only survivor of the eight in hiding was Otto Frank, his father. Ana was sent to the Nazi concentration camp at Auschwitz on September 2, 1944, and later to Bergen-Belsen, where she died of typhus around mid-February 1945, about two months before the camp was liberated. In 1947, just two years after the war ended, her father published his daughter's diary.

Annelies Marie Frank, - Anne Frank - conocida en español como Ana Frank (Fráncfort del Meno, 12 de junio de 1929 - Bergen-Belsen, febrero o marzo de 1945), fue una niña alemana con ascendencia judía, mundialmente conocida gracias al Diario de Ana Frank, la edición de su diario íntimo, donde dejó constancia de los casi dos años y medio que pasó ocultándose, con su familia y cuatro personas más, de los nazis, en Ámsterdam (Países Bajos) durante la Segunda Guerra Mundial. Una vez fueron descubiertos en su escondite, Ana y su familia fueron capturados y llevados a distintos campos de concentración alemanes. El único superviviente de los ocho escondidos fue Otto Frank, su padre. Ana fue enviada al campo de

concentración nazi de Auschwitz el 2 de septiembre de 1944 y, más tarde, al de Bergen-Belsen, donde murió de tifus alrededor de mediados de febrero de 1945, unos dos meses antes de que el campo fuera liberado. En 1947, apenas dos años después de terminada la guerra, su padre publicó el diario bajo el título *La casa de atrás* (en neerlandés, *Het Achterhuis*). El *Diario de Ana Frank* es uno de los testimonios más conmovedores de una víctima del delirio a que llegó el mundo por la acción de los nazis.

for her age. She detailed her experiences and insights while she and her family were in hiding, living in a constant fear of being arrested.
