Albert Doja dhe Shfaqja e Antropologjisë në Shqipëri Lulu.com

Kjo përmbledhje është një botim i veçantë që sjell një pjesë të vogël të kontributit shkencor të akademikut Albert Doja. Kryesisht janë disa shkrime tashmë të shqipëruara që kanë për qëllim të tregojnë se si antropologjia është shfaqur dhe zhvillohet në Shqipëri në udhëkryq midis Europës Lindore dhe Perëndimore. Ndër të tjera, Albert Doja është përpjekur të identifikojë format e ndryshme të dallimit midis praktikës së studimeve folklorike-etnografike dhe antropologjisë bashkëkohore, për të theksuar domosdoshmërinë e përqafimit të metodologjisë antropologjike në studimet e sotme shqiptare, si një mënyrë për të analizuar dhe interpretuar veçoritë shqiptare si pjesë integrale e proceseve dhe trashëgimisë botërore. In this autobiographical novel, Albania's most renowned novelist and poet Ismail Kadare explores his relationship with his mother in a delicately wrought tale of home, family, creative aspirations, and personal and political freedom. "Houses like ours seemed constructed with the specific purpose of preserving coldness and misunderstanding for as long as possible." In his father's great stone house with hidden rooms and even a dungeon, Ismail grows up with his mother at the center of his universe.
