Reading, Writing, and Phonics Too ® is a how to teach reading and writing book for parents and teachers. Instructions for parents and teachers combine with hands-on lessons for their children. The parent/teacher portion of the book provides instruction and illustrations plus coaching notes with each page of the 37 student lessons.
