couch. Despite a couple of millennia as human companions, this is a breed that is surprisingly healthy. They have an average life expectancy of between 12 and 16 years, so bringing one of these little guys into your home is likely to give you a long-term companion that can entertain you, and may demand a bit of entertainment in return. It is hard to imagine that these sturdy, affectionate dogs were once on the brink of extinction. Over the last 60 years, they have become an

extremely popular breed because of the combination of easy care, adorable appearance, and charming personality.
